

















## Section 2. Primarily Voluntary Movements (Cognitively Directed)

Developmental Levels		Pattern Components	2.f. Grasp of the Pellet (Prone or Sitting)
Left	Right	L	R
12 months			<b>Fine Pincer Grasp:</b> Between fingertips or fingernails (test with thread or yarn) <b>Thumb:</b> Proximal joint slightly flexed, distal joint flexed
10 months			<b>Pincer Grasp:</b> Between distal pads of thumb and index finger <b>Thumb:</b> Proximal joint extended, distal slightly flexed, opposed to index finger
9 months			<b>Inferior-pincer Grasp:</b> Between ventral surfaces of thumb and index finger <b>Thumb:</b> Proximal and distal joints extended, beginning opposition
8 months			<b>Scissors Grasp:</b> Between thumb and side of curled index finger <b>Thumb:</b> Proximal joint extended, distal slightly flexed
7 months			<b>Inferior-scissors Grasp:</b> Rakes object into palm with flexed fingers <b>Thumb:</b> Proximal and distal joints flexed
6 months			Rakes and contacts object during unsuccessful attempt to grasp, fingers extended <b>Thumb:</b> Proximal and distal joints flexed, adduction
5 months			Visually attends to object, without attempt to grasp
Natal			No visual attention to object, no grasp
